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About this document

This document provides information about the known issues and limitations, and the defects fixed in SASVA Release Management 2.1.1.

Known limitations

This section lists the known limitations in Release Management 2.1.1.

- \ In the **Tree** view, the descriptions of Epic, Story, or Task do not load on the user interface
- \ After you add a new task, its content does not appear uniformly in the **Detail** view

Fixed defects

This section lists the defects fixed in Release Management 2.1.1.

1. Defect: The UI labels for Add Bulk Users and Add User are incorrect.

Cause: The text on labels were inconsistent.

Solution: Updated labels for clarity and consistency

Defect: After rebuilding a project, the release plan strategy options are not reset.

Cause: The default reset logic was missing.

Solution: Added logic to restore the default values on rebuild

3. Defect: After a release is created, the status of an issue that was assigned to someone shows **Pending**.

Cause: The updated status was not getting triggered.

Solution: Updated the code to reflect the user assignment status correctly

4. Defect: While editing, duplicate Git and Jira connector names are allowed

Cause: A duplicate name validation was missing.

Solution: Added validation to prevent duplicate connector names

5. Defect: The count of user stories is updated incorrectly after the Jira sync.

Cause: After every sync, the number of user stories kept getting incremented.

Solution: Fixed the sync logic to maintain accurate story count

6. Defect: While assigning a user to a Story, a runtime error occurs

Cause: There was an unhandled exception in assignment logic.

Solution: Added an exception to handle and prevent runtime errors

7. Defect: The **Category** tag is not visible on expanding a story after a release is created.

Cause: UI rendering issue

Solution: Updated the UI to ensure tag visibility

8. Defect: Text is missing under the **Search** box on the **Users** page

Cause: Improper UI element rendering

Solution: Fixed the UI to display the missing text

9. Defect: Error messages are unclear and difficult to read

Cause: Background styling affected message visibility

Solution: Updated the UI background for better legibility

10. Defect: Able to submit a Story without adding any records

Cause: A workflow validation was missing.

Solution: Updated the submission logic to enforce required entries

11. Defect: Misalignment of the header menu

Cause: Misaligned menus

Solution: Corrected header layout

12. Defect: Unclear error message when editing a user

Cause: The message was unclear.

Solution: Revised the error message for clarity and consistency



13. Defect: 500 Internal Server Error when downloading test case report

Cause: Connection timeout due to network restrictions

Solution: Whitelisted the IP

14. Defect: Architecture and Design report images do not open

Cause: The file format was not supported.

Solution: Allowed image viewing

15. Defect: 500 Error when creating a release with an existing name

Cause: A duplicate name validation was missing.

Solution: Added clear error messages for validation issues
