About this document

This document provides information about the known issues and limitations, and the defects fixed in SASVA Release Management 2.1.2.

Known limitations

This section lists the known limitations in Release Management 2.1.2.

- 1) In the **Tree** view, the descriptions of Epic, Story, or Task do not load on the user interface
- 2) After you add a new task, its content does not appear uniformly in the **Detail** view

Fixed defects

This section lists the defects fixed in Release Management 2.1.2.

- 1) Defect: `Something went wrong` error message displayed during release planning

Cause: Underlying issues in release planning logic

Solution: Fixed the issues to ensure smooth release planning
- 2) Defect: On Questionnaire page, **Select All** option gets unchecked after revisiting the same question.

Cause: Missing field validation logic

Solution: Implemented validation logic to verify the field.
- 3) Defect: Super admin can enter alphabets in the phone number field while adding a new tenant admin on the User Management page.

Cause: Number validation logic was missing.

Solution: Implemented validation logic to verify the field.
- 4) Defect: While Assigning user in the release plan, the user assignment filed is getting cropped.

Cause: UI unable to accommodate the information due to space constrained.

Solution: Resized the field to accommodate the information.

- 5\ Defect: Release is saved in both Release list and Draft folder when user retries during release editing.

Cause: Retry logic not handled properly during release editing.

Solution: Implemented retry mechanism to prevent duplicate saving of the release.

- 6\ Defect: Bulk Upload feature in Admin UI lacks instructions for file upload.

Cause: Missing UI instruction for file requirement.

Solution: Added the UI message for instruction about the supported file format and required data.

- 7\ Defect: User story status show as pending even after any of the sub task status is pending.

Cause: Inconsistent status update logic.

Solution: Updated logic to reflect accurate story status based on sub-task status

- 8\ Defect: In User Management, users are not automatically deactivated after leaving the organization.

Cause: Missing deactivation logic

Solution: Implemented validation logic for automatic deactivation.

- 9\ Defect: Plugin upload and delete API access not restricted to super admin in User Management.

Cause: Missing access control

Solution: Implemented logic to restrict plugin upload and delete API to super admin users.

- 10\ Defect: Jira sync issue, the changes made in Jira are not reflecting in the UI.

Cause: Jira sync issue causing the delay in status update.

Solution: ~ Fixed Jira sync logic to ensure timely UI updates
