Feature	Limitations
Project plan preview page	In the Tree view, the descriptions of Epic, Story, or Task do not load on the user interface.
Project plan preview page	After you add a new task, its content does not appear uniformly in the Detail view

Fixed defects

This section lists the defects fixed in Release Management 2.2.

Feature	Defect	Solution
	Something went wrong error message displayed during release planning	Fixed the issues to ensure smooth release planning
Build project use cases	On the Questionnaire page, Select All option gets unchecked after revisiting the same question.	Implemented validation logic to verify the field
User management	Super admin can enter alphabets in the phone number field while adding a new tenant admin on the User Management page.	Implemented validation logic to verify the field

Feature	Defect	Solution
Project plan preview page	While Assigning user in the release plan, the user assignment filed is getting cropped.	Resized the field to accommodate the information
Publish release	Release is saved in both Release list and Draft folder when user retries during release editing.	Implemented retry mechanism to prevent duplicate saving of the release
User management	Bulk Upload feature in Admin UI lacks instructions for file upload	Added the UI message for instruction about the supported file format and required data.
Releases- User stories	User story status show as pending even after any of the sub task status is pending.	Updated logic to reflect accurate story status based on sub-task status
User management	In User Management, users are not automatically deactivated after leaving the organization.	Implemented validation logic for automatic deactivation
User management	Plugin upload and delete API access not restricted to super admin in User Management.	Implemented logic to restrict plugin upload and delete API to super admin users.
Backend service	Jira sync issue, the changes made in Jira are not reflecting in the UI.	Fixed Jira sync logic to ensure timely UI updates
